Monday: Math: ch 6 lesson 1 Add tens
ELA: blend & segment phonemes in words w/ suffixes -ed & -ing
 -Read aloud Carlee's Garden & justify the plot using details from the text.

Tuesday: Math: ch 6 lesson 2 Count on tens & ones
ELA: substitute phonemes in words, associate the sound /ar/ w/ ar, & build, blend, & read r-controlled words spelled -ar.
 -echo read *Frog and Toad Together* and make revisit our predictions regarding what seeds need in order to grow.

Wednesday: Math: ch 6 lesson 3 Add tens & ones

Thursday: Math: ch 6 lesson 4 Guess, check, & revise to solve double-digit addition problems
ELA: add initial & final phonemes, ending -es & r-controlled or & ore.
 -spelling; spelling test; read aloud & justify the plot using details from the text.

Friday: Math: ch 6 lesson 5 Add tens & ones w/ regrouping
ELA: Unit 3 week 4 reading test (tested on sight words & comprehension of *Frog & Toad Together*
Comprehension strategy: visualize
Comprehension skill: plot
Phonics: inflected endings -ed, -ing, & r-controlled ar
Phonemic Awareness: blend and segment phonemes to uncover the onset and rime in r-controlled words spelled -ar
