Monday: Math: ch 6 review adding and subtracting tens, adding tens & ones, regrouping.
ELA: Add phonemes er & est & justify the word meaning, Identify the base word & ending in words w/ comparative endings -er & -est.; justify the sequence of events in the story *Back and Forth*.

Tuesday: Math: ch 6 test (assessed on adding & subtracting tens & ones, regrouping, related facts)
ELA: blend & segment phonemes to read words w/dge at the end to produce the /j/ sound; identify the sequence of events in *Where are My Animal Friends* using details from the text.

ELA: substitute phonemes to build & read new words; review -r controlled ur, ir, & er; contractions 's, 've, 're; spelling test on comparative endings -er & -est; read aloud book on animals & what they do during diff. seasons.

Friday: Math: ch 7 lesson 3 Make picture graphs
ELA: Unit 3 week 6 reading test (tested on sight words & comprehension of *Where are My Animal Friends*)
Comprehension strategy: prior knowledge
Comprehension skill: sequence
Phonics: comparative endings -er & -est; dge /j/
Phonemic Awareness: blend and segment phonemes to read words w/ -er & -est, dge;
