Monday: Math: ch 7 lesson 4 Read picture graphs ELA: substitute initial phonemes to build and read words with long a spelled ai or ay. Read aloud *A Dinner* Surprise and draw conclusions regarding how Alice feels about her brother.

Tuesday: Math: ch 7 quiz (assessed on how to read and make picture graphs and tally charts to compare items) ELA: blend & segment phonemes to read words w/'s or possessives (ex: girl's vs. girls') and echo read Mama's Birthday Present. We will make & revisit our predictions regarding what birthday present Mama gets.

Wednesday: Math: ch 7 lesson 5 Make bar graphs ELA: review comparative endings -er & -est; read & build words with dge at the end of them. -partner read *Where are My Animal Friends* & justify where animals go when its cold & how they feel using details from the text.

Thursday: Math: ch 7 lesson 6 Read bar graphs ELA: review comparative endings -er & -est and dge /j/ sound in words; review long a spelled ai & ay and possessives 's vs. s'; spelling test on long a words spelled ay or ai; read aloud book on treasures and conclude the treasure's significance using details from the text.

Friday: Math: ch 7 lesson 3 Make picture graphs ELA: Unit 4 week 1 reading test (tested on sight words & comprehension of *Mama's Birthday Present*) Comprehension strategy: monitor and fix up Comprehension skill: draw conclusions **Phonics:** long a: ai, ay & possessives ('s vs. s') Phonemic Awareness: blend and segment phonemes to read words w/ possessive /'s/ and long a: ai & ay

Reading- We will learn about the genre realistic fiction using the text Mama's Birthday Present and justify our conclusions regarding why a gift for Mama was significant to Francisco.
