Monday: Math: ch 1 lesson 9 Use doubles to subtract
ELA: Build, segment, blend, and read words with prefixes -un & -re.

-Read *The Cardboard Box* and justify the theme of the story using details from the text.

Tuesday: Math: ch 1 quiz (assessed on counting back, Subtracting all and zero, and using doubles to subtract)
ELA: segment, blend, read, and read words w/ long vowels i & o.

-Read Aloud book and justify the theme of the story utilizing details from the text.

Friday: Math: ch 1 lesson 12 Fact Families Involving (+) and (-) and order of operations
ELA: Unit 5 week 5 reading test (tested on sight words & comprehension of *Ben Franklin & His First Kite*)

Comprehension strategy: ask questions

Comprehension skill: theme

Phonics: prefixes -un & -re, long vowels i & o

Phonemic Awareness: segment, blend, & read words w/ long vowels i & o, as well as prefixes -re & -un.
