Monday: Math: ch 1 lesson 6 Write a # sentence
ELA: Build, segment, blend, and read words with short vowels a, e, i, o, and u.

-Read *A New Neighborhood* and justify the characters & setting of the story using details from the text.

Tuesday: Math: ch 1 quiz (assessed on counting back, Subtracting all and zero, and using doubles to subtract)
ELA: Alter the initial, medial, & final phonemes to build & read new words w/ short vowels.

ELA: Unit 1 week 1 reading test (tested on sight words & comprehension of *Iris & Walter*)
